- New Codes
- Deleted Codes

Medicare Preventive Services

National Coverage Determinations (NCDs)

- Some of the Preventive Services has a National Coverage Determination (NCDs)
- Provides additional information including coverage and non-coverage, reasons for at risk, age requirements, etc
- At a minimum level, staff-assisted supports consist of clinical staff (e.g., nurse, physician assistant) in the primary care setting who can advise the physician of screening results and who can facilitate and coordinate referrals to mental health treatment.

Medicare Preventive Services

CPT, HCPCS, and Category III Codes

- CPT Category II Codes (80000-99999)
- Medicare G-codes
- Category III codes (0042T-0639T)
- Other notes

Medicare Preventive Services

Patient Liability

- Applied or Waived copayments/coinsurance and Medicare Part B deductible
- Previously diagnosed patients

Medicare Preventive Services



Telehealth eligible

- Some preventive services
- Sensitive topics
- COVID safe

Medicare Preventive Services

Coverage Requirements

- Underlying conditions
- Low or high risk
- Asymptomatic
- Hereditary
- Gender
- Ethnicity
- Age

Medicare Preventive Services

Modifier Usage

- 33 - Preventive Service
- GG - Performance and payment of a screening mammogram and diagnostic mammogram on the same patient, same day
 - To show a screening mammography turned into a diagnostic mammography
- PT - colorectal cancer screening test; converted to diagnostic or other procedure. Medicare only waives the deductible.
- TS - Follow-up service
 - Example: submitting patient pre-diabetes claims

Medicare Preventive Services

Terminology

- Screening - in medicine, is a strategy used to look for unrecognized conditions or risk markers. To identify abuse or misuse.
- Counseling - The provision of assistance and guidance in resolving personal, social, or psychological problems and difficulties especially provided by a professional.

Medicare Preventive Services

ICD-10 codes

- What's Changed for new and deleted codes and effective dates
- Code specified code(s) versus unspecified code(s)
- Code anatomical sites (e.g., breast quadrants)
- Check the NDC for any Change Request (CR)
- Review the NOTE for additional specific ICD-10 codes
- Contact your MAC

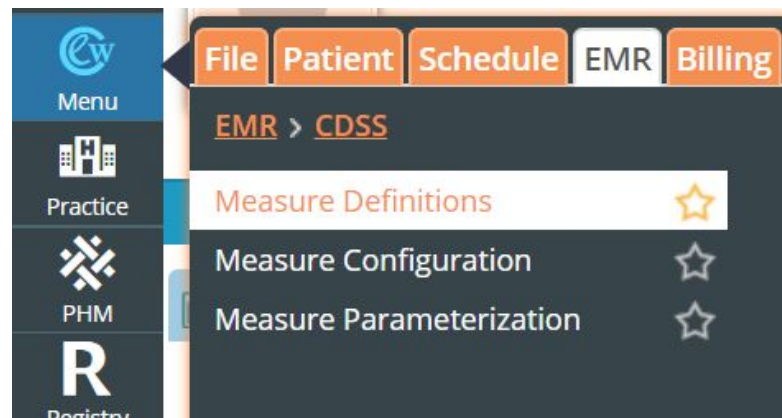
CDSS Alerts

CDSS Alerts for Preventive Services

- What does CDSS stand for?

Clinical Decision Support System

- Menu>EMR> CDSS Alerts
 - CDSS Configuration: Enable or Disable
 - CDSS Definitions:
 - Denominator-what triggers the alert
 - Numerator -what need to be done in order to satisfy the alert
 - Associate an order set -to help satisfy the measure
 - Reference document -click on pencil



CDSS in Progress Notes

CDSS Alerts can be located in 2 places in PN

- Quick link in Progress Note under the Patient Dashboard
- ICW/R Chart Panel (this is a My Settings option)

CDSS Alerts

- Last Done
- Frequency
- Due Date
- Orders (Quick order) vs OS (order set)
- Status (Red is non compliant) (Green is compliant)
- Hand-Suppress the alert (temporarily or forever)
- H-Historical Data

Preventive Medicine

- Depending on the CDSS alert you may need to access Preventive Medicine to satisfy the measure.
- Smoking Cessation is one of those alerts.
- Smoking is found under the Counseling folder on the left and requires a date to be entered on when the patient was counseled to quit smoking.

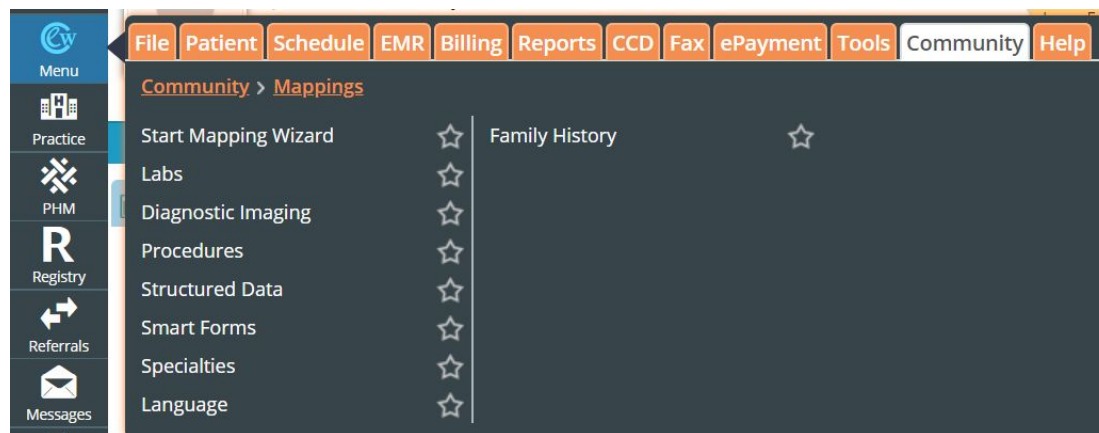
